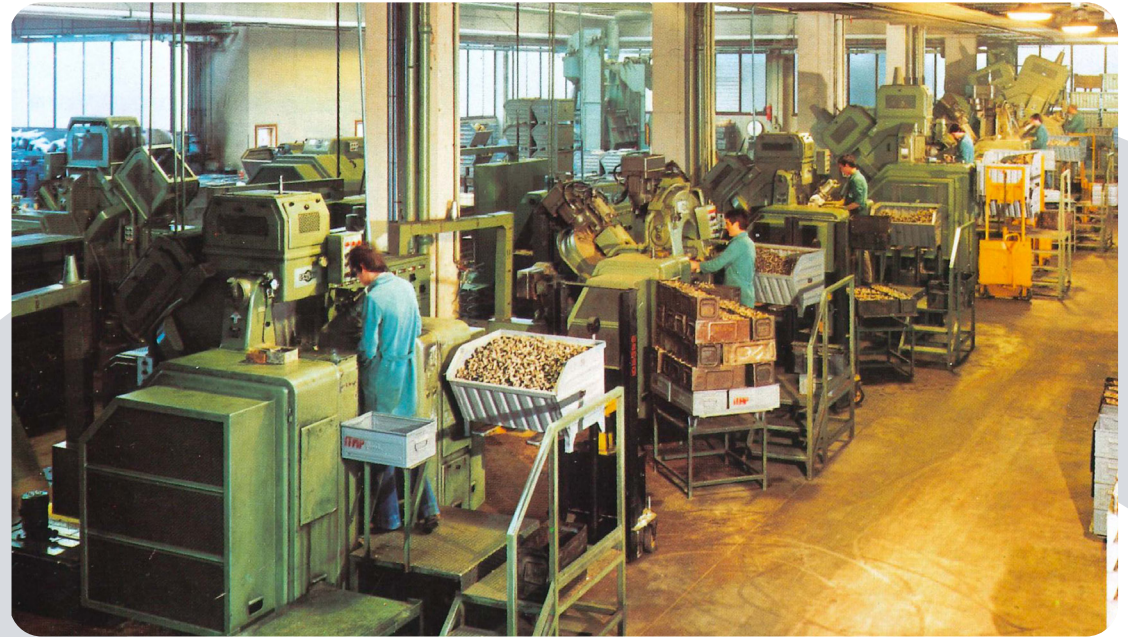
THE FIGURES AND ROLES THAT HAVE MADE HISTORY
